## **BRAIN STORM OF TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGE**

Brainstorming is popular method of expressing creative ideas in the process of solving a scientific or technical problem.

Thanks to brainstorming you can get practical experience of using language tools to achieve a specific goal. In addition, brainstorming promotes critical thinking, generates social mobility, develops communication, information and technological competences, creativity, collaboration skills. Brainstorming is used when there are several options for solving a particular problem.

It is in the process of discussion that students learn to express their own position, to argue and defend it, to respect the opinions of others, to avoid conflicts and so on. They develop the ability to generate new ideas, to listen carefully, to independently process information, to ask pertinent questions, to draw critical conclusions.

Brainstorming is just what you need when learning a foreign language in a team. Brainstorming is some jokes and a comfortable atmosphere. During the brainstorming session there are neither teachers nor students, we need to encourage and support each other, try to formulate our thoughts briefly but clearly.

If you want to work with brainstorming, you need to create a mind mapping. This will help you write about problems or goals or ideas.

Also you can start with the problem and ask "how could we cause this?" It will help you create problems, you're ready to start solving them.

Brainstorming is analysis. Analyze words, sentences, or something you hear in a foreign language.

Brainstorming technique was first designed to be used with groups, but it can also be used by a single person privately to generate ideas.

Also each brainstorming session can include one or many techniques to stimulate creative thought – techniques such as writing, talking aloud, drawing, creating games, and developing diagrams. Most experts suggest an individual should begin by writing down as many ideas as they can – without censoring or considering the logic of each idea. This will give the individual many possible solutions to combine or to develop further.

## Brainstorming Technique:

- The freewriting technique (areewriters ignore grammar and spelling during a freewriting session, as they aim solely to generate a variety of ideas.)
  - Free speaking(individuals record their own voice talking).
  - Helps students not forget their ideas while waiting for their turn to speak.
  - Does not block people because of shyness.
  - Individual brainstorming may be less stressful.

Therefore, the use of the method of brainstorming in the educational process allows to solve the following tasks: to stimulate students' creative activity; to combine the obtained theoretical knowledge with the practical; to activate educational and cognitive activity; learn how to work in a team; to respect any opinion expressed. This method will help students conduct discussions both in real-world situations and during online communication.
